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The Opportunity

Radford University invites nominations and applications for the position of **Assistant Vice President of Radford Online**. This is a full-time, 12-month, administrative professional (AP) faculty position with the ability to be located in Radford or Roanoke.

The Assistant Vice President of Radford Online is responsible for the strategic leadership, development, integration, and management of online, distance, and hybrid education initiatives under our newly organized Radford Online single service model.

Purpose of the Position

This position ensures the delivery of high-quality, accessible, consistent, and innovative Radford Online programs that support student success and align with the university's mission and strategic goals. The Assistant Vice President will work internally with academic departments, faculty, and staff, and externally with our OPM partner and allied vendors to ensure the success of online programs and enhance the overall online learning experience.

The Assistant Vice President of Radford Online is responsible for the strategic leadership, development, integration, and management of online, distance, and hybrid education initiatives under our newly organized Radford Online single service model. The Assistant Vice President, in collaboration with deans and enrollment management, will align faculty expertise, student demand, and market needs to manage and enhance a healthy portfolio and grow student enrollment in Radford Online programs. The Assistant Vice President will collaborate with colleagues across the institution on online faculty development, student support, marketing, and enrollment management. Reporting directly to the Provost and Senior Vice President for Academic Affairs, the Assistant Vice President will be a key member of the Provost's Senior Staff and Academic Affairs Leadership Team.

Strategic Leadership for Radford Online

- Develop and implement a comprehensive strategic vision for online learning that integrates existing online and hybrid strengths and is aligned with the university's institutional mission;
- Lead the Radford Online Advisory Council and serve on university committees as assigned to support university initiatives.

Radford Online Program Portfolio Management

- Identify and prioritize opportunities for online and hybrid program growth and expansion including the development of fully online undergraduate degree programs and new graduate certificates.
- Collaborate with academic departments to develop a continuous improvement Curriculum Lifecycle for online and hybrid programs that includes developing, launching, assessing, and modifying online and hybrid programs;
- Use financial modeling to sustainably plan and manage Radford Online programs;
- Seek external funding to support Radford Online initiatives;
- Develop and report on metrics related to online courses and programs, including in-person student enrollment in online courses, fully online undergraduate and graduate

Program Support and Coordination

- Coordinate with the Center for Innovative Teaching and Learning to provide ongoing faculty development and training in effective online teaching practices, and to foster a culture of innovation and continuous improvement in online teaching;
- Develop a comprehensive sustainable compensation model for course development and delivery;
- Coordinate with Student Success and Graduate Affairs to develop and implement effective student support services for online learners, including academic advising, technical support, and tutoring;
- Support the monitoring of student progress and assist in providing timely interventions to address challenges and promote student success;
- Collaborate with ITS on the selection, implementation, and maintenance of technology tools and platforms to support online learning.
- Collaborate with ITS to ensure the reliability and security of online learning systems..

Quality Assurance

- Establish and maintain rigorous quality standards for online programs, including course design, delivery, assessment, and refresh/redesign;;
- Support the creation of a consistent Radford Online design and student experience across all online programs;
- Monitor and evaluate the effectiveness of online and hybrid programs and make necessary adjustments;
- Ensure compliance with relevant accreditation standards and regulations;
- Collaborate with colleges and departments to audit and maintain a current inventory of online and hybrid programs.

- Serve as the academic lead on OPM and other vendor partnerships.
- Serve as project manager for the OPM partnership, liaising with colleges and divisions, troubleshooting, and leading program administration.
