Position Profile

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Radford University invites applications and nominations for a 9-month Assistant **Professor of Nursing** in the College of Nursing's Undergraduate Department at Radford's main campus to support its **prelicensure BSN track**. This role offers a meaningful opportunity to shape the academic journeys of emerging nursing students into a vibrant community focused profession.

The Assistant Professor will join a student-centered and mission-driven **College of Nursing** that values innovative teaching, strong faculty engagement, and continuous program improvement. Faculty in this role play a critical part in delivering high-quality nursing education that is rigorous, relevant, and responsive to the evolving healthcare landscape. Prelicensure faculty will prepare students for dynamic healthcare careers through rigorous, evidence-based education, hands-on clinical experiences and mentorship. Teaching responsibilities include in-person lectures, skill laboratory instruction, and clinical teaching in acute care and community settings for undergraduate students.

Beyond the classroom, this role provides the opportunity to collaborate with dedicated colleagues on curriculum development, assessment, and strategic initiatives that advance the College of Nursing's Undergraduate Department and the university's broader academic mission. The Assistant Professor will contribute to a culture of excellence through shared governance, service, and scholarly engagement, while helping ensure that the prelicensure BSN track remains responsive to workforce needs and professional standards. Faculty are supported in their role through a robust onboarding experience, are paired with a mentor, and may be enrolled in the College of Nursing's graduate certificate in nursing education.

This position is ideal for an educator who is passionate about nursing education, values meaningful connections with students, and is motivated by the opportunity to make a lasting impact in a public university setting known for strong faculty-student relationships and a commitment to service.

- ❖ Minimum of five years of adult clinical nursing experience.
- ❖ Ability to teach undergraduate nursing coursework aligned with the prelicensure BSN curriculum.
- ❖ Strong communication, organizational, and interpersonal skills, with the ability to collaborate effectively in an academic environment.
- ❖ Participation in on-campus activities and service responsibilities.
- ❖ Prior teaching experience in classroom and clinical learning environments.

Preferred Qualifications

- ❖ Evidence of active scholarly or professional activity within the past two years.
- ❖ Familiarity with curriculum design, assessment, and continuous program improvement.
- ❖ Demonstrated interest in academic service, shared governance, and collaborative program development.
- ❖ Experience in education at the university level

The Radford University [College of Nursing](#) is a recently elevated and nationally recognized academic unit dedicated to preparing highly skilled, compassionate nurses to meet the evolving needs of healthcare systems locally, nationally, and globally. Officially designated as a standalone College in January 2024, Radford became the first public institution in Virginia to establish a separate College of Nursing, reflecting the strength, rigor, and growing impact of its nursing programs.

The College of Nursing recently enrolled its **largest undergraduate class in history**, with approximately **1,295 nursing students**, including **700 new students on the main campus**.
